

May Block of the Month

Thank you for agreeing to do a block for me. I have chosen an easy tessellating star block to be done in Black and White.

For each block unit, cut 4 black strips and 4 white strips $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$.

Cut 4 black strips and 4 white strips $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$.

ASSEMBLY

Place the $4\frac{1}{2}$ strips right sides together at right angles.

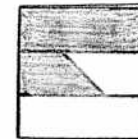
(See diagram)



Sew across the pieces in a diagonal line.

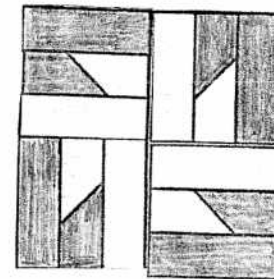
Trim away excess fabric beyond sewing line leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ in seam.

Press open. Sew a white strip and a black strip to each side of the pieced strip.



Repeat 3 more times.

Assemble with the black as the background and the white as the star, as shown in the diagram.
